1. A list of the providers commissioned by the CCG to provide CAMHS Tier 2 services, and a list of the Tier 2 services each provider is commissioned to provide

In Calderdale, CAMHS are no longer split into tiers but work towards the THRIVE model. South West Yorkshire Partnership Foundation Trust (SWYPFT) and Northpoint Wellbeing have been working together in implementing the new THRIVE model for Open Minds Partnership and this has had positive impacts across the service(s). The THRIVE model is an integrated, person centred, and needs led approach to delivering mental health services for children, young people, and their families. It conceptualises need in five categories: Thriving, Getting Advice and Signposting, Getting Help, Getting More Help and Getting Risk Support. Emphasis is placed on prevention and the promotion of mental health and wellbeing. Children, young people, and their families are empowered through active involvement in decisions about their care through shared decision making, which is fundamental to the approach. They will continue to work together as part of the newly named Calderdale Open Minds Partnership (replacing the acronym CAHMS).

Northpoint Wellbeing Limited provide:

- Single Point of Access service which is named 'Getting Advice & Signposting' or First Point of Contact (FPoC)
- Getting Help service (previously would be classed as Tier 2).

2. A list of the providers commissioned by the CCG to provide CAMHS Tier 3 services, and a list of the Tier 3 services each provider is commissioned to provide

SWYPFT provide:

- Getting More Help (previously would be classed as Tier 3).

Within the above service, the pathways are:

- Complex
- Eating Disorders
- Urgent
- Learning Disability Team

SWYPFT are also commissioned to carry out neurodevelopment assessments which include Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder assessments on school aged children and adolescents aged 6-18.

Calderdale & Huddersfield Foundation NHS Trust (CHFT) and Oakdale Centre CIC are commissioned to carry out ASD assessments on pre-school aged children aged 0-5.

No CAMHS Tier 4 services are commissioned by NHS Calderdale Commissioning Group, they are commissioned by NHS England as correctly stated below.
